



## **Nevada AmeriCorps State Members Serving Outside the State of Nevada**

### **Policy and Procedures (effective August 5, 2011)**

**\*TRIAL POLICY FOR ONE YEAR TO BE REVIEWED QUARTERLY\***

**POLICY:** It is the policy of Nevada Volunteers that AmeriCorps State members are assigned to serve the unmet needs of Nevada's residents and environs. In rare instances, members may be assigned outside Nevada when the common benefit of the service includes the state of Nevada. All out of state assignments MUST have written prior authorization from Nevada Volunteers.

#### **PROCEDURES:**

1. Nevada AmeriCorps State programs are expected to enroll and assign all of their AmeriCorps members to host sites within the state of Nevada.
2. Due to specific local needs or the common needs of a specific geographical location (greater Lake Tahoe, for example), and based on a program's model and total number of members awarded, up to 5 members may be placed out of state for program's with greater than 50 members and up to 2 members may be placed out of state for program's with less than 50 members on a case by case basis.
3. All out-of-state host sites must be approved in advance by Nevada Volunteers in writing.
4. In the event of a natural disaster, Nevada Volunteers may approve out of state placements for more Nevada AmeriCorps State members after consultation with the subgrantee and the Corporation for National and Community Service.
